Features :

- Are on the edge of a town or a city
- Contain **detached houses**
- Have gardens and garages
- People are often **commuters** = People who travel in and out of the city for working.
- Continue to grow even now

CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT:

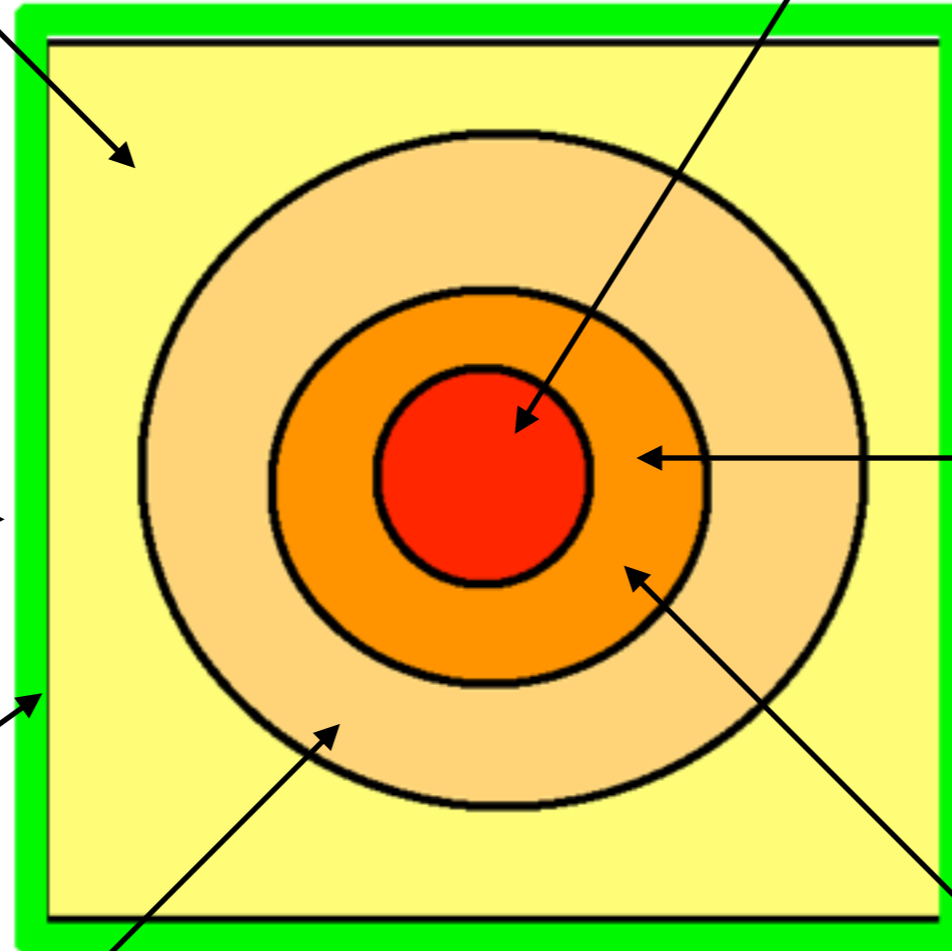
Features :

- Was the first area to be built
- contains lots of shops, offices and businesses
- Historical buildings and museums
- High buildings with storeys.
- The location is accessible : transport stations such as bus, train, underground...
- The land is very expensive (it costs a lot to rent or buy)

INNER SUBURBS:

Features :

- Contain **semi-detached houses or detached houses**
- The houses are bigger than inner cities because there is more space to build.
- There are often **facilities** such schools, churches, parks and supermarkets
